# Defined Scope Before Construction

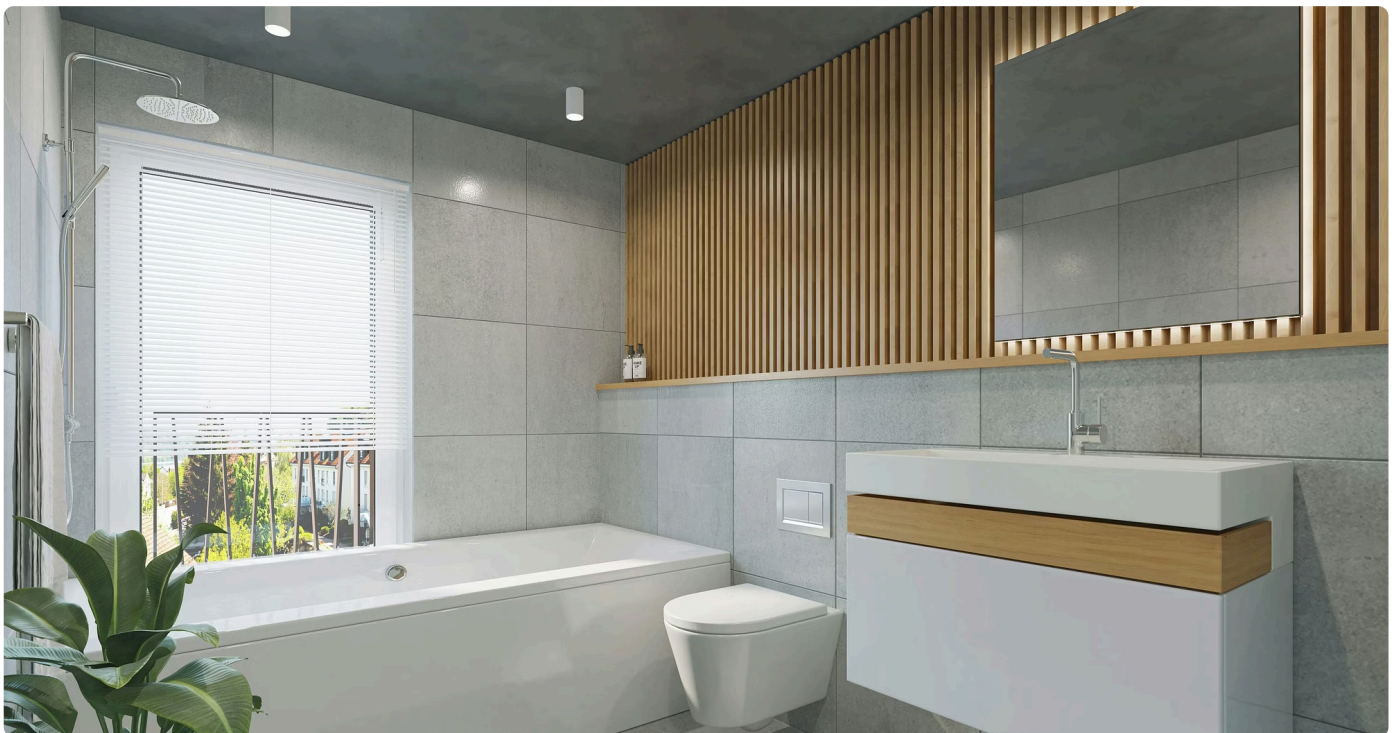

# Realistic Scheduling with Built-In Float

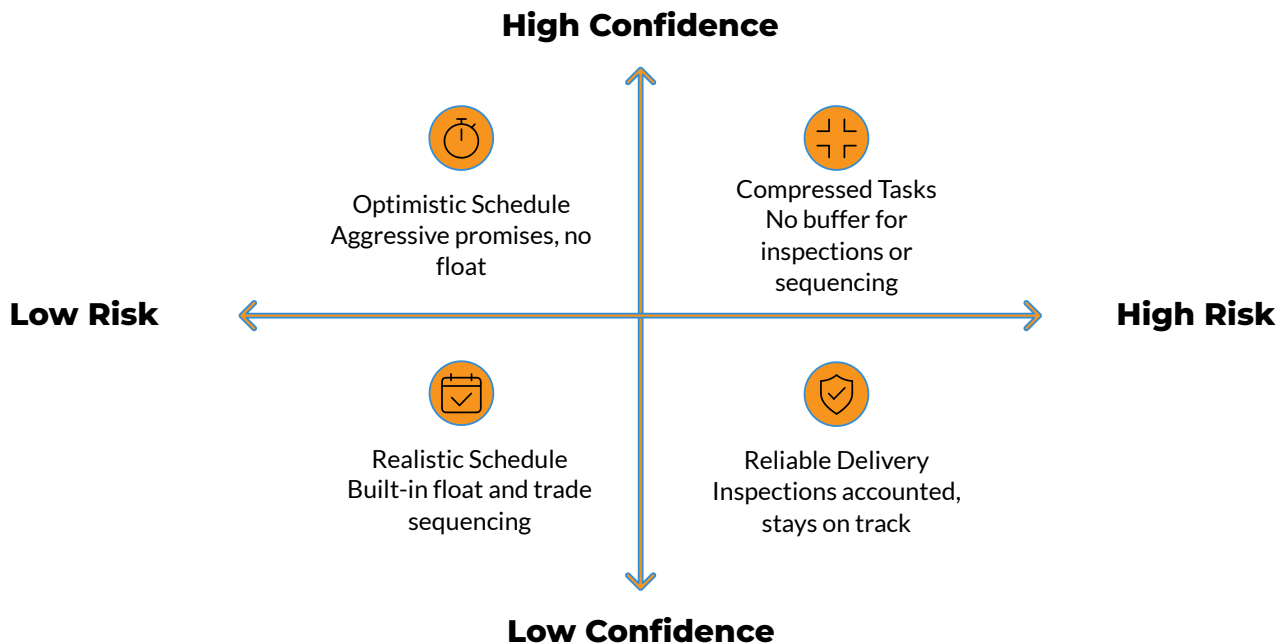

By establishing a communication protocol, you foster a collaborative environment that enhances trust throughout the remodeling process.

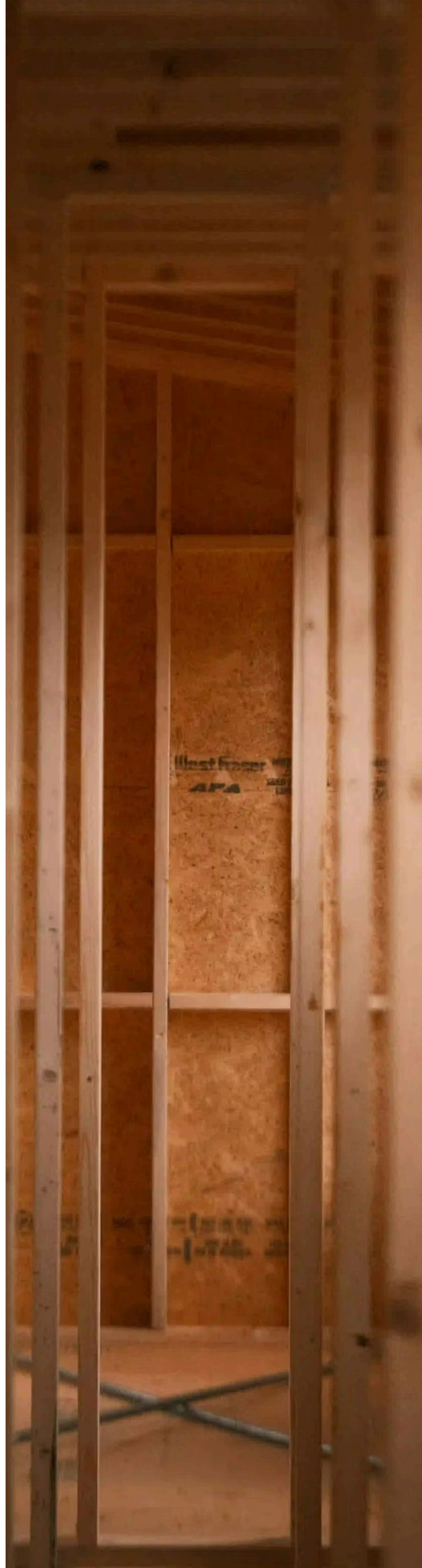
